Dear Brother Dong and your Co-workers,

After we discovered that Bruno Frossard from Brazil had moved to Toluca and attended several meetings in the church in Mexico City, and heard that you intend to work in Toluca, we sent you a letter on September 30, 2008, stating that we have been laboring in that city for several years in a blended and coordinated fellowship among the coworkers in Mexico. The Lord has raised up a number of saints who stand on the ground of oneness in that city and the Lord's table has been established there as well. In order to avoid any confusion in the development of the church there, we asked you to respect the labor and fellowship of those saints, and to not send any workers there who would not respect the fellowship and coordination which had raised up the church in Toluca.

*Your co-worker, Ezra Ma, responded to us in his letter on September 30 stating definitely that you will not begin separate meetings where a church already exists. Nevertheless, your workers have done exactly the opposite of what was promised! We are greatly troubled and dismayed to learn that just a month our letter to you a meeting separate from the church in Toluca was started by your workers, and was even declared to be THE FIRST MEETING OF THE CHURCH IN TOLUCA. After much prayer and fellowship, we have come to the firm conclusion that what has been "started" in Toluca by your co-workers, in complete disregard of the ground of oneness, is in fact not a church, but a division!*

Therefore, since you have created division and withdrawn yourselves from having fellowship with the churches in Mexico, we felt obligated to warn the saints in Mexico that you are doing a different work than what we are doing, and that they should have nothing to do with your work, with your workers, or your publications. For this same reason, we also ask your workers to please stay away from the churches in which we have labored diligently for so many years to perfect His testimony according to the New Testament ministry as brought to us through brothers Watchman Nee and Witness Lee.

For the sake of not being responsible for causing more confusion and division, we would again ask you to please not send any workers or believers who propagate your work to contact either the saints or the churches in Mexico. At the same time, we are praying and hoping that you will stop doing a work of division and return to the fellowship of the Body. We have attached a copy of the warning we issued to the saints so that you may be fully aware of the offence you have caused not only to us, but to the whole Body of Christ.
